Town of Hickory Grove Regular Board Meeting January 14th 2025

Meeting was called to order by Chairman Gary Northouse at 6:00 p.m. He noted that meeting notices were posted at the town shop and on the town website.

Present at the meeting were Gary Northouse, Al Wester, Rhonda Gildersleeve. Tim Biba, Gary Klein, and Scott Downs,.

With the information presented Northouse motion to reclaim the lot and be open for purchase by Lisa and Francis Trumm. Motion second by Gildersleeve. Motion carried.

End -of -year budget was had some questions to be addressed at the next meeting.

Log cutting and zoning permits were viewed by the board.

There was a long and short paper made to draw for the position on the ballot for Phil Henneman and Klein. It was determined the long paper would be Henneman and the short one would be Klein. As the long paper was drawn, Henneman will appear first on the ballot for Supervisor 2.

There was a discussion about whether to keep or sell the trailer owned by the township. It has not been used for 5 years, is too small to haul our tractor on and is deteriorating by sitting idle. It needs breaks and rewiring for lights. A new deck was installed on it recently. Gildersleeve mentioned she would check with someone that works on trailers to get an idea how much it would cost to fix and the value of the trailer.
