

**Town of Hickory Grove**  
**Regular Board Meeting**  
**Wednesday February 11, 2026**

Meeting was called to order by chairman Gary Northouse at 6:00 p.m. He noted that meeting notices were posted at the town shop and on the town website.

Present at the meeting were Rhonda Gildersleeve, Al Wester, Gary Klein, George Gunderson, Larry Schultz, Tim Biba, Brian Northouse and Gary Northouse.

Klein motioned to approve the agenda, seconded by Gildersleeve. Motion carried.

Minutes were passed out, and after reading them, Klein motioned to accept the minutes. Gildersleeve seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Accounts payable were looked at by the board and approved for payment with a motion from Klein, seconded by Gildersleeve. Motion carried.

Expenditures 18468-18493 were reviewed. Northouse motioned to accept the expenditures, seconded by Gildersleeve. Motion carried.

There were no concerns voiced from Hickory Grove citizens in attendance. Gildersleeve gave a report from the WTA meeting she attended. Board of Review training was given and the a lot of discussion on the role, consolidation, and concerns of the EMS.

Truck update: We are on the high priority list.

Roads to be seal coated in 2026 are Church Road .70 miles; Dry Hollow Road 1.54 miles; Sleepy Hollow Road 2.59; Breezy Hill Road 1.2 miles totaling 6.03 miles.

The bid for gravel will be for approximately 440 ton.

Logging and zoning permits were viewed by the board for filing.

Motion was made by Klein and seconded by Gildersleeve to pay the refund of tax due to: David Anderson Estate \$5646.06, Trumm Farms LLC \$623.34, Cathman Trust \$8.00, Dennis Swenson \$59.94, Jacob Frazier \$14.50, and Ephraim Lapp \$1640.41.

Tax refunds will not be refunded due to amounts being less than \$5.00 for Leon Martin .06, Roger Strack \$1.98 and Samuel Lapp \$2.15.
